## **Information on the processing activity:**

### **Purposes of the processing activity:**

Planning and implementation of events, trade fairs, etc., including inviting and looking after guests.

Furthermore, photos and/or video recordings are used to document the events on the WITTMANN Group's website and social media channels.

### **Legal basis of the processing activity:**

Processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject. The processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or a pre-contractual measure pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR.

### **Categories of recipients:**

Processor (processor within the meaning of Art. 4 No. 8 GDPR in conjunction with Art. 28 GDPR)

Internal (marketing, sales, management)

Other recipients (users of social media channels and websites)

### **Data transfer to a third country:**

There is no planned transfer to third countries.

## **Additional information obligations:**

### **Storage period of personal data:**

The personal data will be deleted by us as soon as the purpose of storage no longer applies and no further storage is permitted or required by law.

### **Rights of the data subject:**

You have a right of access (pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR) to the controller regarding the personal data concerning you as well as the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), erasure (Art. 17 GDPR) and to restriction of processing (Art. 18 (1) GDPR). Furthermore, you have the right to object to the processing (Art. 21 GDPR) and the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).

### **Right of appeal:**

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
